Theory Training

Theory Evaluation

The Theory Evaluation begins with a written exam based upon the concepts covered in the operator's reference instruction manual. These tests are graded and returned to the trainees. Then the exams are reviewed to guarantee understanding and a minimum score of 70 percent is needed in order to pass this portion of the training.

Practical Training

The practical training is included in the hands-on part. It is here that the ones training are shown the safe operating procedures, such as the shutdown and parking measures and the pre-use check procedures. Every trainee has the chance to operate the equipment and practice the skills they learned in Theory Training under the helpful eye of the course trainer in a setting which is safety controlled.

Practical Evaluation

The Practical Evaluation is where the trainees are assessed to assure they have reached a minimum level of skill. The trainees are then assessed on an individual basis utilizing the machinery in a reasonably challenging course setting. Once the evaluation is done, the ones training are de-briefed and given the opportunity to deal with any problems they may have about any portion of the course.
